



Dunedin Stirling Soccer Club Financial Assistance Application 2021/22

Dunedin Stirling Soccer Club is a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation dedicated to providing superior quality soccer opportunities to the youth in our community. Our club has limited financial aid available, mostly provided by sponsors and current or alumni players/families. To qualify for a scholarship, players/families must meet specific criteria. All scholarship applications are reviewed by the Board of Directors and all decisions will be communicated via email.

There is a 2-step process you **MUST** complete for Dunedin Stirling Soccer Club financial assistance:

1. Complete the 1-page application and submit with the following required documentations:
 - a. Copy of child's free lunch or reduced lunch letter with official signature
 - b. A personal written statement of financial hardship
 - c. Tax return from 2020 or current pay stub showing monthly family income
2. Email your application and requested documents to bod@dunedinsoccer.com or mail/drop off at Dunedin Stirling Soccer Club, 981 Jerry Lake Court, Dunedin, FL 34698.

Once you have completed these 2 steps, you will receive an email notification once the Board has been able to review your application. If approved, you will be provided with a discount code that may be used during your online registration process. It is important that you do not share the code with anyone as it is strictly created for your application. Violation against this may result in loss of scholarship and require you to pay full registration amount.

All information submitted is **STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL** and is used for the **SOLE** purpose of determining award amount, and parent's ability to assist with funding. Failure to submit required documentation with your application will delay the process for approval.

All recipients of financial aid may be required to complete volunteer hours for club events and or administrative duties. There are many opportunities to do so (e.g., field set up & break down at home games, staffing at tournaments, staffing at fundraising events, videotaping games, admin support ... or if you have an idea, business, or talent you can offer). Our staff will notify you of your required volunteer assignment well in advance of the event.

Scholarship recipients are required to maintain in good standing with the club and are to attend all practices and games with their team.
